

APPLICATION TO JOIN UCAR, the UPMART Class Action on Representation.

SECTION 1: Do you qualify to join UCAR?

BACKGROUND INFO. In courts within Australia, solicitors and barristers have a monopoly on legal representation, which is a 7.7 Billion-dollar industry!! The competitors to the barristers and solicitors and their lush monopoly are Common Law Lawyers (CLL's) and other like people, who have gained valuable court skills through experience and hard work. CLL's are not **members of the bar** (the club). It is up to magistrates and judges whether CLL's can represent you in your matter in court. It depends on the mood of

the judge! It is fickle. It is random. The same CLL will be denied one day then permitted the next. Why do they deny? The excuse used by magistrates and judges to deny you representation of your choice, is that CLL's are not legal practitioners according to **their** legislation or **their rules** and are **not members of the bar**. By stopping CLL's, magistrates and judges protect the monopoly and the interests of "the system". Magistrates and Judges do not like CLL's because they use **powerful legal arguments that solicitors and barristers will not use**. CLL's are prepared to fight

the system whilst barristers and solicitors must uphold the system, even when they know it is wrong. Barristers and solicitors don't like CLL's because they usually work for FREE. Generally, the first priority for members of the bar is to protect the **system**. The second priority is to get your money, and the last priority is to help you! **Your right to choose the representative of your choice is a human rights issue.** You are now invited to join UCAR, a class action to establish **your right** to choose the **representative of your choice** for your legal matters **in any court**.
